120 DAYS: UNDOCUMENTED IN AMERICA, THE MOVIE will be shown at St James, Parish Center on April, 22, 2018 from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm with a discussion panel. 120 Days is a documentary that chronicles the life of a family of undocumented immigrants who have lived and worked in the United States for twelve years. Father and husband, Miguel Cortés, may be forced to leave the country as a result of his immigration status. In exchange for agreeing to leave the country voluntarily after paying a bail of \$5000, the judge allows Mr. Cortés a period of 120 days to order his affairs before leaving his wife and two daughters in the U.S. Petaluma-North Bay Rapid Response, Il Poverello, Order of Secular Franciscans, and Abraham Solar, Hispanic Ministry St Vincent, are supporting this showing.
