The Catholic Diocese of Santa Rosa in collaboration with a multitude of Christian churches in the Santa Rosa area are hosting a prayer event at Cardinal Newman field. We will celebrate the virtue of Hope in the midst of suffering, pray for healing in our communities, and dedicate ourselves to hope in action as the Body of Christ. Space is limited so please call for more information, including location, and to make an appointment: (415) 534-5878 Please leave a detailed message with your full name, number, date and services you're interested in, and the best time to call you back.

FOR NATURALIZATION ASSISTANCE, PLEASE BRING:

1. A copy of your green card (both sides).
2. List of all your trips out of the U.S. during the past five years, including dates.
3. List of addresses where you have lived, worked and/or attended school for the past five years, including start and end dates.
4. If you are currently married, spouse's full legal name, date of birth, Social Security or alien number (A#), date and place of naturalization, and current address.
5. Information about all your prior marriages and all of your current spouse's prior marriages, including date of marriage, and divorce/separation.
6. If you have children, their full name as it appears on birth certificate, dates of birth, residency card A# or Social Security number, and addresses.
7. Proof of income (e.g. taxes/pay stubs) and/or proof of recent recipient of public benefits (e.g. Medi-Cal/CalFresh).
8. Documentation of all arrests and/or convictions, including reason for the arrest, date, place, and outcome/disposition (if applicable). Bring ALL arrest and court documents, even if the charges were dropped. During the clinic, you will receive free advice from licensed attorneys regarding your Naturalization and, when possible, help in filling out your application. **BEWARE OF NOTARIO FRAUD** – do not accept immigration advice from unlicensed attorneys or unlicensed representatives.
