Today's feast, the Solemnity of All Saints, is the centerpiece of three days that point to doctrines we proclaim each time we say the Apostles' Creed: "We believe in the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting." And while the days and our hearts may be dark, the readings today are bright with the light of faith. John's vision in the book of Revelation reveals dazzling angels and white-robed saints gathered in triumph around the throne of God. In the responsorial psalm we sing our longing to see God's face, and in the second reading John writes that we are God's children and will, in fact, see God "as he is" (1 John 3:2). This is our hope. This is God's promise. Today we celebrate the triumph of those who already gaze on the face of God. - Scholar applied to St. Vincent de Paul High School no later than December 7, 2019 and completed the HSPT test no later than January 11, 2020.

**The Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe Scholar Award** is awarded to a limited number of incoming bilingual freshmen who maintained a GPA of 3.5 during their 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade years and have met all the requirements of the award. **Applicant Eligibility**

- Maintained a 3.5 GPA during scholar's 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade academic years.

- Active participant in their Parish.
- Applies to St. Vincent de Paul High School no later than December 5, 2020 and completes the HSPT test no later than January 16, 2021.
